NSW GOVERNMENT'S PLANNING WHITE PAPER

NSW Planning Minister, Hon Brad Hazzard, released the long-awaited Planning White Paper. The paper and the accompanying draft bill lay the groundwork for legislation to be introduced in the Spring session of the NSW Parliament.

Amendments aim to ensure compliance with LEPs & use DCPs for guidance only. Failure to strictly comply with the DCP standards should not in its self be a reason for refusing an application.
